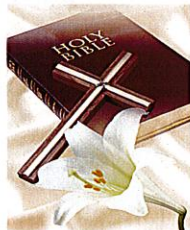

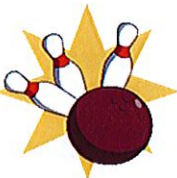
Some of those in attendance have allergic reactions or breathing difficulties triggered by perfumes or other strong scents.

A Change of Beadles

Ten years ago George Sjaarda succeeded Hartley Fischer as the Beadle here at Knox. He has decided to retire from this role and Session has appointed Paul Stewart to succeed him commencing March 1st.

In Scottish churches the beadle was the ‘head janitor’ of the church building. Bibles were costly and so the pulpit Bible was locked up between services. Placing it on the pulpit was one of the beadle’s duties. Because Reformed Churches have a high regard for Scripture, this evolved into a ceremonial procession which emphasized that the reading and preaching of the Scriptures was the central focus of Presbyterian worship.

Knox has been appointing Beadles to carry in the Bible since the 1950’s. Pictures of those who have served may be found in the hallway outside the west door at the front of the church. We look forward to hanging George there in the near future and we thank Paul Stewart to agreeing to take on this role.
